**V. ELECTION OF TWO MEMBERS TO THE STATE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES DISTRICT EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE FOR EACH DISTRICT, I.E. DISTRICT 67, DISTRICT 68, AND DISTRICT 69.**

The precincts in District 67 are all of 11 part of 12, part of 13, and all of 32. The part of 12 in District 67 is all of the precinct except a small portion to the west of Unionville Brief Road and north of Lawyers Road to U. S. 601. The part of 13 in District 67 is west of North Carolina 200, north of Henry Baucom Road, and south of Haigler Road and Old Fish Road.

The precincts in District 68 are 5, part of 7, part of 12, part of 13, all of 14, all of 15, all of 16, all of 17a, all of 17b, all of 18, all of 19, all of 20a, all of 20b, all of 21, all of 22, all of 28, all of 29a, all of 29b, all of 29c, all of 30, all of 31, all of 33, part of 34, all of 35, all of 37a, all of 37b, all of 38a, all of 38b, all of 39, all of 40, all of 41, and all of 42. The part of 7 in District 68 is east of Landsfod Road. The part of 12 in District 68 is all that is not in District 67. The part of 13 in District 68 is all that is not in District 67. The part of 34 in District 68 is west of the end of Tomberlin Road.

The precincts in District 69 are all of 1, all of 2, all of 3, all of 4, part of 7, all of 8, all of 9, all of 10, all of 23, all of 24, all of 25, all of 26, all of 27, part of 34, all of 36, and all of 43. The part of 7 in District 69 is that part not in District 68. The part of 34 in District 69 is that part not in 68.

*For all split precincts I will divide the votes equally for purposes of these elections; however, any voting delegate must live in the district.*

**I. ELECTION OF DELEGATES TO ANNUAL CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT CONVENTIONS**

**A. ELECTION OF DELEGATES, 18, TO THE ANNUAL 8<sup>TH</sup> CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT CONVENTION**

Precincts in Congressional District 8 are 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9, 10, 11, 25, 26, 27, 36, and 43. These precincts will elect 18 delegates to the 8<sup>th</sup> Congressional District Convention. The total number of votes each precinct has is divided equally among the delegates present, but if less than the allowed number of delegates is present, the total number of votes is limited to the number of delegates present.

**B. ELECTION OF DELEGATES, 63, TO THE ANNUAL 9<sup>TH</sup> CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT CONVENTION**

The precincts in the 9<sup>th</sup> Congressional District are 5, 6, 7, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17a, 17b, 18, 19, 20a, 20b, 21, 22, 23, 24, 28, 29a, 29b, 29c, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 37a, 37b, 38a, 38b, 39, 40, 41, and 42. These precincts will elect 63 delegates to the annual 9<sup>th</sup> Congressional District Convention. The number of votes each precinct has will be divided equally among the delegates present, but if less than the allowed number of delegates is present, the total number of votes is limited to the number of delegates present.

**II. ELECTION OF DELEGATES, 81, TO THE BIENNIAL STATE CONVENTION.**

The county convention, as a whole, will elect 81 delegates to the State Convention. Each precinct is entitled to vote the number of votes assigned to each precinct. The number of votes held by each precinct is to be equally divided among the delegates present, but if less than the allowed number of delegates is present, the total number of votes is limited to the number of delegates present.
